*Grooming and Dress Guidelines

SENIOR AWARDS, BACCALAUREATE, AND COMMENCEMENT EXERCISES

Cap and gown required. TASSEL is worn on the right side of cap.

Young Ladies: Wear a cool, comfortable dress or skirt. Wear shoes with a medium size (height) heel or flats (*no tennis shoes or flip flops permitted*). Avoid wearing jewelry on the outside of the gown. Avoid bringing a purse or cell phone.

Young Men: **Absolutely, no jeans, shorts, flip flops or tennis shoes.** Wear dark blue or black slacks, shoes and socks. Wear a collared button up shirt (suit or sports coat is optional) with tie.
