LOCAL

Communities are committed to seeing their local students succeed and offer scholarships to help cover costs for school.

- Civic/service organizations (e.g. Kiwanis, Rotary)
- Education & Community foundations
- Professional associations related to your field of interest (e.g. marketing association, performing arts center)
- Employers (e.g. McDonald's)

SCHOOLS

Your high school or college/trade school may offer opportunities for scholarships based on special talents (e.g. honors, science, athletics), or for financial need.

REGIONAL

Organizations and companies might offer scholarships for students in multiple counties.

- Professional sports teams (e.g. Miami HEAT, Miami Dolphins, Tampa Bay Rays)
- CareerSource regional office
- Employers (e.g. Starbucks)

STATE

Florida Department of Education provides scholarships and grants through the Florida Financial Aid Application.

NATIONAL
