RIVEROAK Technical College provides high school students with the opportunity to take technical classes (electives) while taking required academic courses at the high school. Students receive industry level training in work environment labs. High school students are exempt from paying tuition while in high school.

Attendance- High School students will be expected to follow the attendance policy of the high school.

Tardy Policy: Students are expected to report to class on time.

Classroom Expectations: Students are expected to behave in a responsible and professional manner. Safety rules must be followed at all times. A student may be dismissed from the program of study if they do not maintain a 2.0 or higher GPA in their Riveroak courses. **Dress Code**- Students are expected to adhere to the dress code as stated in the Suwannee District Code of Conduct. If the program has specific dress requirement then those must be followed.

Discipline- A student must be respectful to faculty, staff, and other students at RIVEROAK Technical College at all times. While in a program a student must follow all guidelines set forth by the institution. A student must comply with the Suwannee District Code of Conduct. Any serious violations will result in immediate dismissal from the program.

The Suwannee County School Board advises that all vocational opportunities will be offered without regard to race, color, national origin, sex, or disability.
