POLICY 5136.01 – TECHNOLOGY RESOURCES AND OTHER ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT

This new policy includes the following:

1. Reference to the definition of technology resources in Bylaw 0100 was added in the first paragraph.
2. Given the popularity of "BYOD" efforts in schools, the second sentence, which may be in your current policy, has been designated Option 1.

Clients are encouraged to re-consider this commitment to supply "any" needed electronic equipment and to prohibit students from possessing electronic equipment.
3. Tablets, smartphones, and e-readers were added to the list of electronic equipment that students **could** be prohibited from using on school property by the Board.
4. If you choose Option 2A, you are restricting the use of technology resources and other electronic equipment/devices in school for educational and instructional purposes only.
5. If you choose Option 2B, you are authorizing the use of technology resources and other electronic equipment/devices for educational or instructional purposes only during instructional time, and you are permitting use of technology resources and other electronic equipment/devices during non-instructional time for any use that is consistent with the District's Policy 7540.03 Student Technology Acceptable Use and Safety.
6. "Camera(s)" are replaced throughout by *technology resources* because that term includes SLR and DSLR cameras, and there are other types of technology resources that can make digital images, e.g. smartphones, tablets, et cetera.
