Seabreeze High School believes all students are responsible for helping to maintain a safe and orderly environment. The rules and procedures listed below are to ensure that Seabreeze High School students are prepared for the real-world.

Students must have **no financial** obligations to be eligible to park on campus.

Students are to park in their assigned areas: Parking decals are required to be visible from the lower driver's side front window of your vehicle at all times.

All vehicles are subject to search.

Students are **not allowed** to sit in their cars or loiter in parking lots **at any time.**

DO NOT use vehicles as lockers or return to your vehicle during the school day. Students needing to access their vehicle during the school day must be escorted by a campus advisor.

Violation of the following actions will result in loss of your parking privilege:

- ❖ Reckless driving and/or speeding. Maximum speed is 5 mph.
- ❖ Ten or more tardies in a semester. (Morning or after lunch).
- ❖ Leaving campus without following school checkout procedures.
- ❖ Vandalism to school or personal property - **reimbursement costs**
- ❖ Transporting students who do not have off campus privileges.
- ❖ Parking in the faculty or visitor parking.
- ❖ Any unauthorized use of your parking decal such as:
 - Allowing another student to drive another vehicle with your parking decal.
 - Removing a parking decal and placing it on an unregistered vehicle.
 - Parking an unregistered vehicle on campus without notifying administration.
- ❖ Any other action that jeopardizes the safety of students and/or staff.

Violation of the following actions will result in loss of your parking privilege after one warning:

- ❖ Sitting in cars or loitering in parking lots. Do not use cars as a locker. **Students should only be in the parking lot when entering or leaving the campus.**
- ❖ Playing car radio too loudly on campus.
- ❖ Failure to park within designated parking areas (North or South lot)-on the grass, non-lined pavement or blocking gates or traffic lanes.

The administration of Seabreeze High School may have to make adjustments concerning student parking, if the need arises.

If an emergency occurs that requires you to drive another vehicle to school, please report the vehicle change to Mrs. Palau immediately upon your arrival to school.

Administrative approval is required before a decal can be used in another vehicle. Any unauthorized use of your parking decal will result in parking privileges/ being suspended or revoked.

The administration of Seabreeze High School takes every precaution necessary to make sure your vehicles are safe. However, Seabreeze does not assume responsibility for your vehicle or other personal items, as is the case in all public parking lots. When your vehicle is on campus it is to be locked. It would also be wise to keep your valuables out of sight.

****To all individuals entering school premises: A principal or designee may search, including but not limited to, their person, briefcase, book bag, purse, packages, locker, storage area and vehicle, upon reasonable suspicion of prohibited or illegally possessed substances or objects.****
