Course Description

This course provides competencies in presentation production issues, basic computer knowledge, illustration software, digital still photography, and photo editing software. Digital Multi Media 2 builds on the concepts covered in Digital Design I. Students will continue to develop their ability to critically think about the design world that exists all around them. Within this course, students will be able to learn how to effectively communicate using digital media tools. DM2 will focus on the understanding and utilization of Adobe Illustrator CC and will also incorporate Adobe Illustrator CC to ensure that students understand the design process and the utilization of these two Adobe programs when creating bitmap images and vector graphics.

Adobe Illustrator CC is an industry standard software used by both artists and graphic designers to create vector images. These images will then be used or company logos, promotional uses or even personal work, both in print and digital form. During this course, students will be actively preparing for the Graphic Design & Illustration Using Adobe Illustrator exam



Course Outcomes

By the end of this course, students will be able to demonstrate the following:

- Proficiency in advanced design
- Understanding of color modes
- Proficiency in using fonts for advanced design
- Proficiency in using illustration software
- Setting project requirements
- Identifying design elements used when preparing graphics.



Types of Assignments

- **Tutorials:** Within these tutorials, students will learn the many tools and functions that exist within Adobe Photoshop CC.
- **Application Projects:** Students will complete independent projects showcasing their understanding of the tutorial they just went through. Specific objectives will be given prior to the start of the Application Projects. At the end of the project, students will have to explain in a short response how they met the criteria for the assignment as well as how they utilized elements and principles of design while creating their image. Projects will either be done individually, in pairs, or in small groups. Adequate time will be allotted in class for all projects; to ensure success, time management is crucial.
- **Project-Based Learning:** Throughout the year, students will create images for Pine Ridge High School. Students will be required to apply their knowledge of Adobe Photoshop CC as well as the elements and principles of design to create aesthetically pleasing images for the school.
- **Quizzes/Tests:** Students will be given multiple choice and short response assessments.

What do I get if I follow class rules?

What happens if I turn in an assignment late?

Work not completed and turned in **by the assigned date** is considered late. If a student is absent on the date work is due, the assignment is due the first day the student returns to school. **COMPLETED LATE WORK** will only receive partial credit (70% of the assignment total). **INCOMPLETE LATE WORK** will not be graded and will result in a zero for the assignment.

Cheating and Plagiarism

- Cheating: Copying another student's work or allowing another student to copy work on any assignment/ test is cheating. Using prohibited materials on an assignment, quiz, or test is cheating. Cheating will result in a make up assignment and parent contact.
