Preliminary Schedule

The schedule received at orientation is a preliminary schedule. The first day of school students receive a new copy of their schedule. This new copy will be your admittance into class.

Student Order Form

Complete an order form before reporting to the cashier inside of the gym. Cash or Check accepted. (Checks *must* include (pre-printed) name, address & phone number). Hold onto your receipt for proof of payment. **NOTE:** *if you've pre-paid for your items on line – do not complete an order form.*

LOCKERS \$5

Includes a school issued combination lock. Present your paid receipt to staff for your locker assignment. Replacement combination lock if lost or damaged is \$5.00. **Note:** ALL STUDENT LOCKERS ARE SUBJECT TO SEARCH WITHOUT WARNING FOR PROHIBITED OR ILLEGALLY POSSESSED SUBSTANCES OR OBJECTS. STUDENT ID

Students are required to carry their I.D. card on their person at all times on campus. First school ID each year is provided free of charge. This card identifies you as a Seabreeze student. A current 2018-19 school ID is required for checking out media books & textbooks, lunch in the café, on or off campus extra-curricular events, and purchasing a parking decal. Replacement ID cards are \$5.00.

OBLIGATIONS - Textbooks/Media materials, Athletic or Lab fees will prevent students from receiving parking and off campus lunch privileges. seabreezehigh.org (10th through 12th grade)

SENIORS, JUNIORS & SOPHOMORES ONLY Off-Campus Lunch ID \$10 PER SEMESTER

To leave campus for lunch Sophomores, Juniors & Seniors must have a consent form signed by a parent/guardian (*completed each semester*), demonstrate good behavior and meet the following attendance requirement: **Cannot exceed 9 tardies and/or absences for 5th period only per semester.**

Note: Freshmen do not have off campus lunch privileges.

SENIORS & JUNIORS ONLY

PARKING (North/South Lots) \$42

Must have no OBLIGATIONS to apply to park on campus. The following items are required:

- 1) **Parking Registration form** signed by your parent
- 2) **2018-19 Student ID**
- 3) **Driver's License**
- 4) **Proof of Insurance** on the vehicle you will be driving to school.

Note: parking for sophomores may become available at a later date. (Funds for this item will be used for the benefit of students & at the discretion of the administration).
