The Unselfie Strategy of the Month

The Student Services Team is excited to present the "Unselfie Strategy of the Month!" *Chapter 4 is titled Empathic Children have a Moral Imagination: Reading to Cultivate Empathy.* This chapter really touches on how important it is for students to read for pleasure. According to research the amount of time that student's willing picks up a book to read for pleasure how decreased significantly over the last few decades. According to the author, many things have contributed to this decline including a decrease in time in our overscheduled world and increased time spent on electronic devices. The author makes it very clear that reading good old fashioned books for pleasure is one of the most important things we can do to help our children. The following quote is quite eye opening: ***Another study found that reading for pleasure at age fifteen was the most important indicator of the future success of the child.*** The question is, what can we do to increase our teenager's time with books? The author suggests that families have a designed reading area, reading the same novel as your teen and selecting books that will increase empathy. Research also shows that parents who read for pleasure have a positive impact in their child's reading behavior. This month, we challenge all families to have a non-digital DEAR (Drop Everything and Read) time in their home. Happy Reading!!
