I. Algebra 1B:

This class will focus on the second half of the Algebra curriculum and students will take the state Algebra EOC at the end of the year. Students will review expressions, equations and inequalities. They will continue to learn about the families of functions with an emphasis on quadratic functions. They will also spend considerable time on polynomials. After successful completion of this course students will proceed to Geometry.

II. Course Expectations

Students are expected to come to class prepared and on time. You will complete notes from direct instruction/videos/book, etc. in your notebook daily. Much of your paper/pencil work will be completed in your notebook. Part of this class will be completed online and it is expected that those assignments will be completed by their respective due dates.

III. Dress Code

Students are expected to follow the dress code set by Volusia County Schools. As a member of the manufacturing academy you should be setting a positive example for other students.

IV. Electronics Policy

You will be using computers and/or your personal electronic device regularly. You may listen to music while working on your individual work as long as one ear is open for safety purposes. If your device, especially your phone, becomes a distraction it will spend the period in a paper bag on your desk.

V. Tardy Policy

Pine Ridge High School provides ample time for a student to arrive in class on time. All students are expected to arrive promptly to their scheduled classes. If you arrive after the bell rings you will be considered late and your attendance will reflect the tardy. I will be utilizing the following tardy policy: 1st offense - verbal warning, 2nd - parent contact, 3rd - lunch detention, 4th - discipline referral.

VI. Make-up Work

Students are allowed two days per excused absence day to turning in missing work. Work for unexcused absences must be completed the following day.

VII. Late Work

Late work will be accepted for reduced credit at my discretion. Any work that is reflected as a 40% in FOCUS will be considered late. Students should have all formative work completed prior to taking a summative assessment.

Students in PRAMA will be held to the highest ethical standards in my classroom. Students caught cheating will receive a zero on the assignment/test, parents/guardians and administration will be contacted, and a notation will be made on the assignment in Focus. Any opportunity for a re-take will be determined by the appropriate administrator.
