**Grading Policy:** Course grades are a reflection of the student's level of academic achievement in regards to the content standards. **60%** of students' nine weeks' grades will be determined by averaging the grades from 3 common summative assessments of content standards; **40%** of the grade will be determined by averaging formative assignments and assessments.

**Submission and Make-Up Policies:** All student work is expected to be turned in by the assigned due date.

**Make up work policy:** Make up work will only be given for excused absences. The amount of time student has to complete the work will be the amount of days excused plus 2. An alternative assignment may be given by teacher. Test make ups will be scheduled at the instructor's convenience during Office Hours.
