



How to Earn Tickets for Bright World Week April 8-12, 2019

Tickets may be earned at **home** by parent and child for the following:

- Attend cultural event for 1 ticket each
- Learn a phrase in another language (parent can learn & earn ticket too)
- Learn to count to 10 in another language (parent can learn & earn ticket too)
- Eat food of another culture at home or in restaurant for 1 ticket each
- Prepare food of another culture (parent earns ticket for cooking and child earns ticket for helping)

Tickets may be earned **at school** by parent and child for the following:

- Participating in cultural game in P.E. (1 ticket is earned each day)
- Parent can come to PE & play game with child to earn a ticket
- Child gets a ticket for trying the cultural cuisine in the cafeteria each day at lunch. (1 ticket each day food is tried)
- Parent can earn a ticket by joining their child for lunch.
- JPK-K students earn two tickets per lap during the Feed BRITE Walk-a-thon. Grades 1-5 earn one ticket per lap. Parents may earn a ticket for volunteering to help during the Walk-a-thon.

A sheet of tickets was sent home with students. Fill out those tickets, cut them out and place them in the prize buckets in the front lobby by Friday afternoon, April 12. If you need more tickets, you may download them from the website at <http://brightschool.com/bright-world>.

When tickets are earned at school, students and parents will receive a ticket to be placed in the prize buckets. Make sure to put your name on the tickets.

Prizes include globe soccer balls, pizza herb growing kit with a Whole Foods gift card, Creative Discovery Museum family passes, a plush Hug-A-Planet, an international candy gift basket, an Interactive Wall Map, a globe and constellations night light, and small carry-on suitcase.
