Course description: Español uno is an introduction of vocabulary, grammar, culture and linguistics to be used later in Español dos.

Objectives: Students will be able to communicate about a variety of topics using the grammar and pronunciation skills acquired.

The following materials are required: Blue/Black ink/ pencil, 2 composition books for the year, workbook and textbook each day.

1st 9 Weeks: Vocabulary: Greetings, Introductions, Saying where you are from, Numbers from 1-10, Exchanging phone numbers, days of the week, the weather, classroom phrases.
Culture: Un mural del metro (Manuel Vega).

Vocabulary: After-school activities, snack foods and beverages, describing yourself and others.
Grammar: Subject pronouns and ser, using de with the verb ser, gustar with an infinitive.

2nd 9 Weeks: Vocabulary: Daily schedules, telling time, numbers from 11-100, describing classes, describing location, expressing feelings.

Grammar: Numbers before nouns, telling time, the verb tener, expressions of frequency, present tense of -ar verbs, the verb estar, the conjugated verb before the subject to ask questions, the verb ir.

Weeks 7 & 8: Vocabulary: Meals and food, asking questions, family, giving dates, numbers from 200-1,000,000.

Grammar: Interrogative words, gustar with nouns, present tense of -er and -ir verbs, the verb hacer, tener to talk about age, de to show possession, possessive adjectives, giving the date, comparatives.

Vocabulary Clothing, shopping, places and events, getting around town, in a restaurant.

Grammar: Tener expressions, stem-changing verbs: e-ie, direct object pronouns, the verb ver, ir + a+ infinitive, stem-changing verbs o-ue, stem-changing verbs e-i.

3rd 9 Weeks: Vocabulary: Describing a house, household items, furniture, planning a party, chores.

Grammar: Ser or estar, Ordinal numbers, Irregular verbs, affirmative tú commands, acabar de + infinitive.

Vocabulary: Sports, Staying healthy, parts of the body.

Grammar: The verb jugar, the verbs saber and conocer, the personal a, the verb doler, preterite of -ar verbs, preterite of -car, gar, zar verbs.

4th 9 Weeks: Vocabulary: Sending e-mails, talking about when events occur, making a phone call, places of interest.

Grammar: Preterite of regular -er and -ir verbs, affirmative and negative words, ¡Qué + adjective! Preterite of ir, ser, and hacer, pronouns after prepositions.

Vocabulary: Daily routines, vacation plans, discussing vacation and leisure activities.

Grammar: Reflexive verbs, present progressive, indirect object pronouns, demonstrative adjectives, Review and Final Exam.
