Special Called Board Meeting
July 29, 2013
6:00 p.m.

The School Board of Levy County met in special session this 29th day of July, 2013 at 6:00 p.m. with Board Chair Cameron Asbell, Robert Philpot, Rick Turner, Paige Brookins, Chris Cowart, and Board Attorney David Delaney present.

Public Hearing 2013-2014 Tentative Millage & Budget: Bob Clemons informed the Board that this was the first of two public hearings to be held concerning the budget and the purpose of the public hearing was to adopt the tentative millage and budget for 2013-2014 as advertised, providing the public the opportunity to offer input. He distributed millage/budget information for review by Board Members.

He pointed out the total discretionary millage reflects a negative change (-3.13%) of the current year's total proposed rate. He reminded the Board that the public hearing for the final millage and budget would not occur until the September 3, 2013 Board meeting. School will be in session and the district will have current information regarding student enrollment (FTE) and staff levels necessary to meet the statutory requirements for class size. The district may even have some idea of the legislators' intent for a special session and a possible proration and/or reduction in funding by that time. After discussion in which the audience was given an opportunity to ask questions and offer input, the following action was taken by the Board.

- 1) Rick Tuner moved, second by Robert Philpot, to approve the tentative millage advertised as follows and adopt the tentative millage resolution.

Basic Discretionary (operating)	0.748
Capital Outlay	<u>1.500</u>
Total Millage	7.334

The total millage reflects a negative change (-3.13%) of the current year's total proposed rate as a percent change of the rolled-back rate as found on line 22 of the schools taxable value. Motion carried by unanimous vote. (See Supplemental Minutes)

- 2) Motion by Rick Turner, second by Cameron Asbell, to approve the tentative budget and adopt the resolution to adopt the tentative budget. Motion carried by unanimous vote. (See Supplemental Minutes)

There being no further business, the Board adjourned.
