#### REGULAR SESSION 9:00 a.m.

The School Board of Levy County met in Regular Session this 28th day of March, 2017 at 9:00 a.m. with Board Chairman Chris Cowart, Vice Chairman Cameron Asbell, Brad Etheridge, Rick Turner, Paige Brookins and Board Attorney David Delaney, present.

**Adoption of Agenda:** Paige Brookins moved to approve the agenda, second by Brad Etheridge, motion carried.

<u>Welcome Visitors:</u> Board Chairman Chris Cowart welcomed all the visitors and asked if anyone from the audience who would like to address the Board. There were none.

**Levy County Schools Foundation:** Donna Turner, Director, LCSF, along with Foundation Board Members Denny George, Ryan Watson, Stacy Swain, Amanda Gibson, Cookie King, and Brian Phillips from Sabal Trail Transmission, presented checks to schools for the "Grants for Great Ideas", in the amount of \$22,951.70 for science and technology funding in the schools. She thanked the Board and all the contributors for their donations to the Foundation, which have totaled \$64,911.00 this fiscal year.

<u>Textbook Adoptions – Social Studies:</u> Carol DuBois gave a PowerPoint presentation to the Board and Public informing them on the Social Studies textbook adoption. She said grades 9-12 adopted Pearson. The elementary and middle school adopted McGraw Hill. After discussion, Rick Turner moved to approve the Social Studies textbook adoption, second by Cameron Asbell, motion carried.

**WMHS Presentation:** Lindsay Legler introduced Arelis Roldan-Rosario, Spanish Teacher at WMHS. Mrs. Rosario gave a PowerPoint presentation showing examples of on-line class work and assignments she does with her students. The Board Members were excited to participate in some of the projects. She said her students become very involved and are anxious to participate in the virtual education. She said the students use technology and chrome books for learning instead of the paper process.

<u>School Choice Enrollment Plan:</u> John Lott, Jr., Assistant Superintendent reviewed the School Choice Enrollment Plan and process for the new 2017-2018 SY. After discussion, Brad Etheridge moved to approve the School Choice Plan, second by Paige Brookins, motion carried.

**2017-2018 School Calendar:** Candy Dean, Assistant Superintendent, shared Calendars A and B with the Board and said Calendar "A" won the majority vote, 311 to 245 votes. After discussion, Rick Turner moved to approve Calendar A. Since there was not a second for Calendar A, Chairman Chris Cowart said the motion to approve calendar A is denied.
