Mrs. Hettrick Cultural Presentation



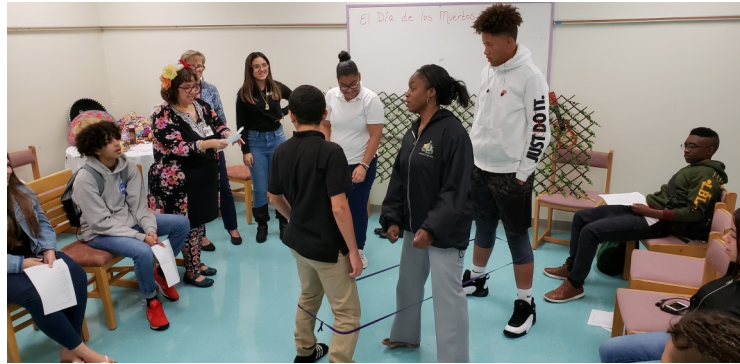

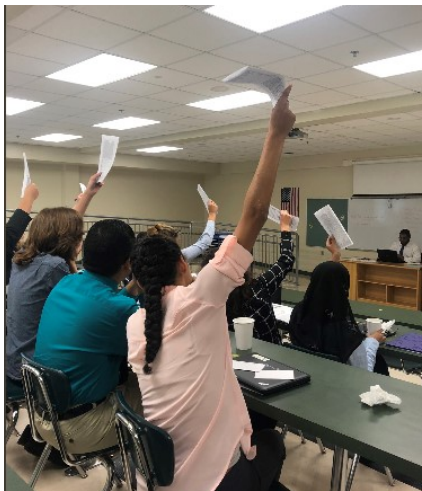
