

NOTICE OF TAX FOR SCHOOL CAPITAL OUTLAY

The Madison County District School Board will soon consider a measure to impose a 1.5 mill property tax for the capital outlay projects listed herein.

This tax is in addition to the school board's proposed tax of 4.886 mills for operating expenses and is proposed solely at the discretion of the school board.

The Capital Outlay tax will generate approximately \$1,072,489 to be used for the following projects:

MAINTENANCE, RENOVATION, AND REPAIR

Safety Corrections and ADA Compliance Requirements, including sidewalk safety

District Wide Renovations and Repairs

Reimbursement of the maintenance, renovation, and repairs paid through the General Fund as permitted by Florida Statute

MOTOR VEHICLE PURCHASE

Lease-Purchase of 1 school bus

Purchase of maintenance vehicles

Purchase of vehicles to transport students

NEW AND REPLACEMENT EQUIPMENT, COMPUTER AND DEVICE HARDWARE AND OPERATING SYSTEM SOFTWARE NECESSARY FOR GAINING ACCESS TO OR ENHANCING THE USE OF ELECTRONIC AND DIGITAL INSTRUCTIONAL CONTENT AND RESOURCES, AND ENTERPRISE RESOURCE SOFTWARE

Enterprise resource software acquired via license/maintenance fees or lease agreements to support school-wide administration and state-mandated reporting requirements

PAYMENT OF PREMIUMS FOR PROPERTY AND CASUALTY INSURANCE NECESSARY TO INSURE THE EDUCATIONAL AND ANCILLARY PLANTS OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT
