1. Before students/faculty/staff arrive on campus

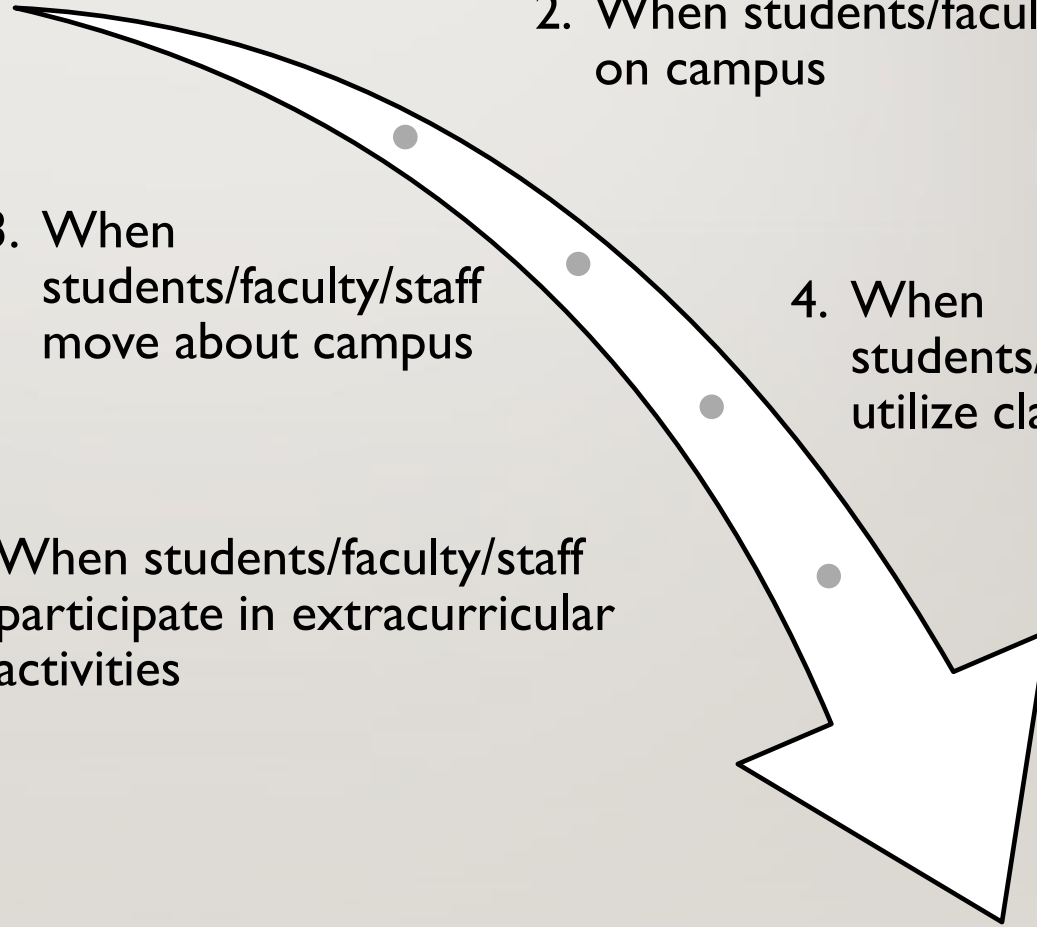
2. When students/faculty/staff arrive on campus

3. When students/faculty/staff move about campus

4. When students/faculty/staff utilize classroom space

5. When students/faculty/staff participate in extracurricular activities

6. When students/faculty/staff leave



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Cleaning

- Additional custodial staff to wipe down high touch areas throughout the school day
- **Provide high volume hand sanitizing stations**
- Purchase of cleaning products that kill the Coronavirus (per the approved label)
- **Purchase and use of high volume atomizing units for sanitizing large areas such as school buses and cafeterias**

Bus Transportation

- Bus routes will run as normal
- **Parents/guardians are encouraged to bring their child to school when possible**
- Self-provided, solid colored masks may be worn by students on the bus
- **Students will be spaced as occupancy allows**
- Buses will be sanitized daily in addition to regular cleaning maintenance

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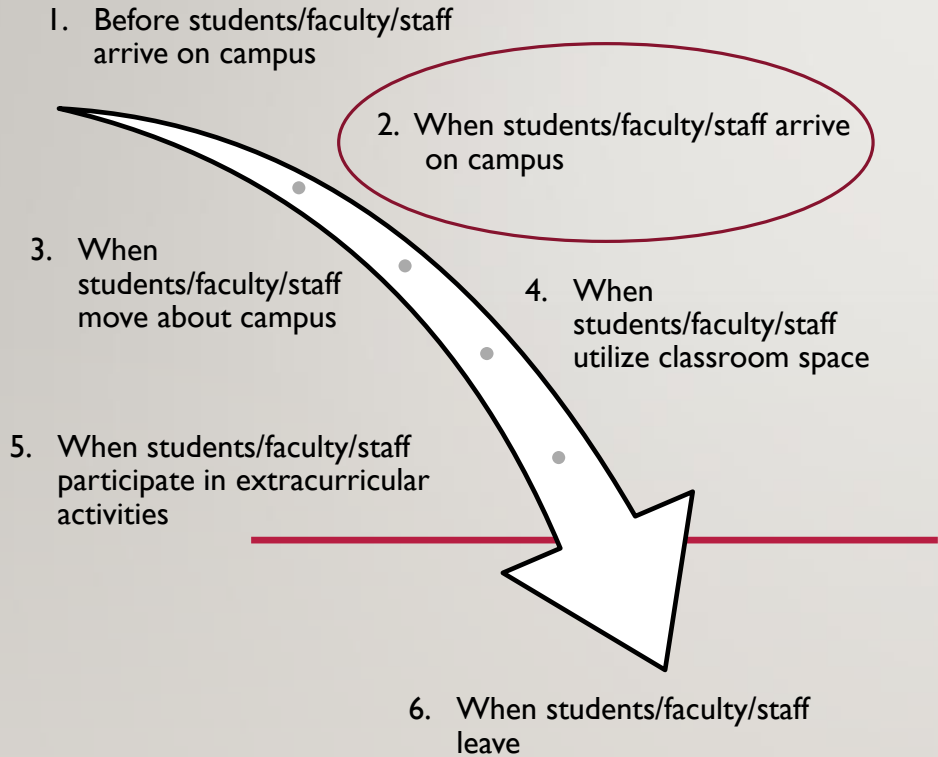
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Medically Vulnerable Students

Parents/Guardians will be contacted to meet for a review of the plan, when needed, to ensure each child's individual needs are being addressed in the new school year.



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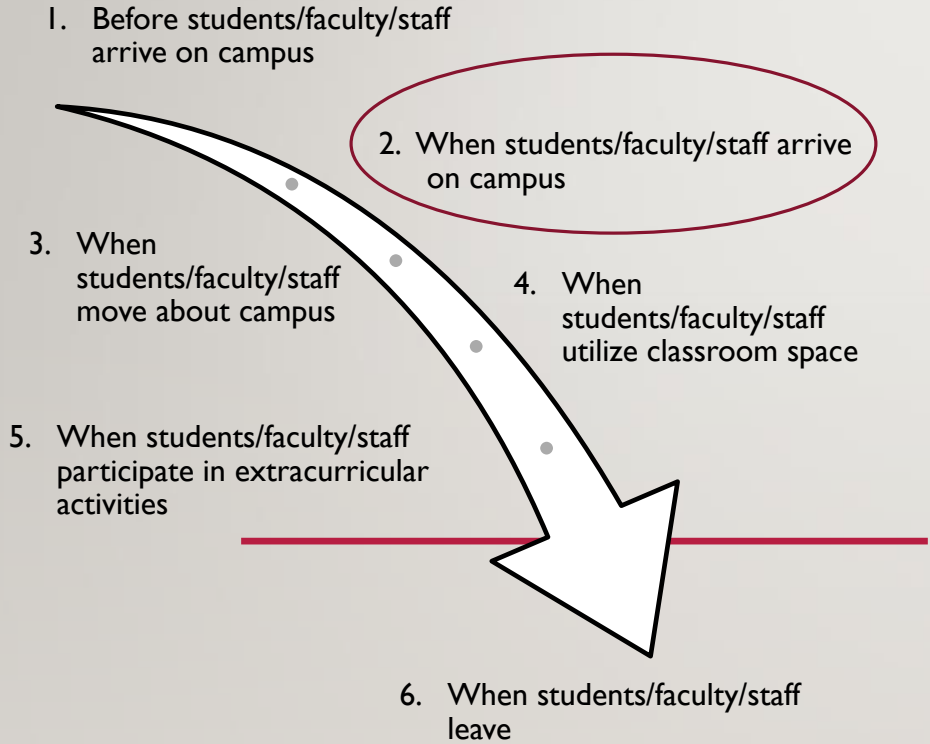
Visitors

Visitors on campus for prescheduled meetings only
Please call for an appointment.
(In most cases, a two-day notice is expected.)

Student Car Drop-Off

All adults are to remain in the vehicle during drop-off

Drop-off children in the school's designated drop-off area only



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Bus Drop-Off

Students will be released in an orderly sequence

Teacher/Staff

Faculty/staff will report directly to their rooms/designated areas as soon as possible upon arrival to work

Temperature checks will be available for faculty/staff upon request

Masks are to be self-provided; however, the school nurse has masks available upon request

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Students

Students will report directly to designated areas once arriving on campus

Students will follow designated routes to provide distance upon entry to campus

Breakfast

Students arriving in time for breakfast will be spaced as space allows

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Student Arrival

All students report to school August 10.

Once students are arriving on campus, parents and visitors may not walk to classrooms, cafeterias, or other areas of the school campus.

It has been a long time since we were last together at school. Everyone needs to extend kindness, courtesy, and grace!

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Students

- **Students will be encouraged to wash hands and/or use hand sanitizer between classes and other transitions throughout the day**

Movement

- **Students will not be allowed to “huddle up” in groups and will be required to transition to the next class or location safely and quickly**

Hallways and Sidewalks

- **Students will use exterior/outside sidewalks to travel the campus to avoid crowding students in hallways as feasible**
- **Elementary grade levels will move about school campuses on a staggered schedule**

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Lunch Periods

- Lunch will take place in the cafeteria
- Lunch schedules will be staggered as time allows
- Student seating will be spaced as space allows

Restrooms

- Restrooms will be stocked with additional supplies to ensure soap/water and paper towels are always available when used throughout the school day

Middle/High Lockers

- Lockers will only be assigned to students that provide a doctor's note of medical need for a locker to avoid crowding in hallways

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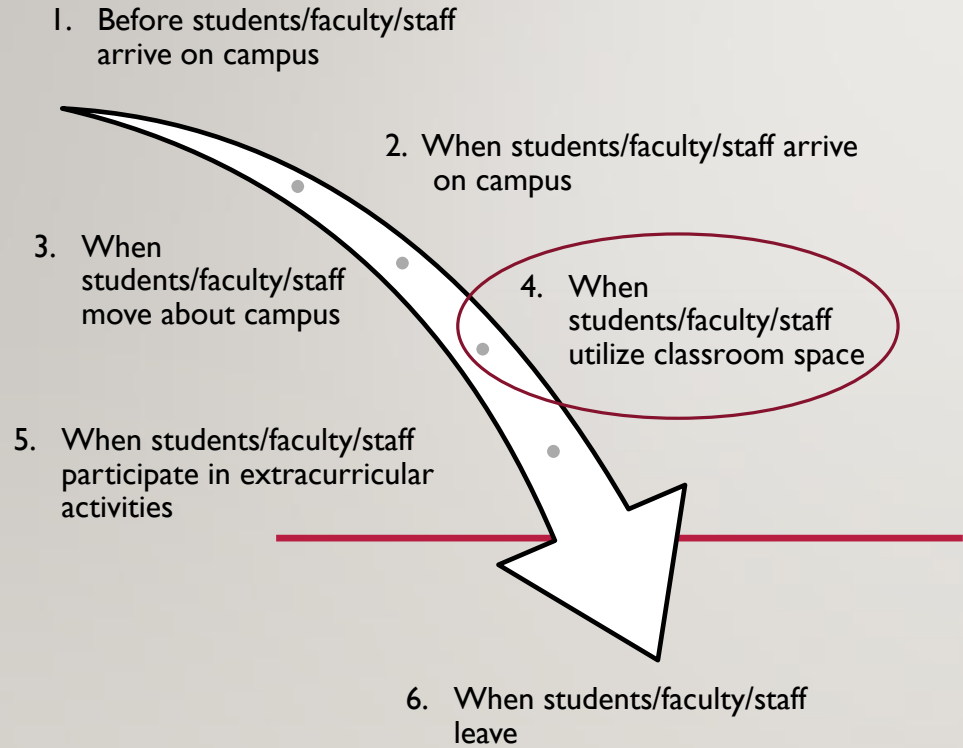
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Classroom Arrangements...

- All unnecessary furniture/items will be considered for removal from the room to allow more spacing for student desks
- Items that cannot be easily cleaned will be considered for removal
- Each teacher will organize the classroom space in the best way possible to maximize social distancing
- Students will use only their own personal supplies. Community use supplies will not be permitted...come prepared!



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Student Supplies

Students should bring daily, every item and supply needed to participate in class. No borrowing or sharing.

Centers and Small Groups

Will take place in the classroom with socially distancing as much as possible.

Chromebooks

Chromebooks are NOT to be shared or borrowed by any student. Only the student to which the Chromebook has been assigned is permitted to use the Chromebook.

All Classrooms and Computer Labs

Will have sanitizing solution and towels to keep the learning environment clean and safe.

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School Campuses

- Closed to the general public without an appointment

Awards/Celebrations

- **Will take place in the classroom**
- No outside guests will be permitted to participate until further notice

Elementary Recess and PE

- **Student occupancy on playground equipment will be limited to smaller groups of children. Take turns. 😊**
- Playground equipment will be cleaned with increased frequency
- Physical education classes will limit the use of shared equipment when possible

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Afterschool Activities, Clubs, Sports, and Events

- The SCSD plans to operate with as much normalcy as permitted considering guidelines at any given time
- Students and spectators at all events are encouraged to social distance as seating allows at both inside and outside venues
