#### **Purchase in the Office Of Student Affairs**

\$20.00 Parking Decals must be purchased with cash & include a filled out printed application form (see link below to print)

Along with their application, students must bring their valid driver's license, registration, and proof of insurance.

#### **Sale Dates For Decals -**

July 31st - Aug. 2nd, Seniors only - 8:00 AM to 12:00 PM

Aug. 6th - 9th - open to Juniors and Seniors - 8:00 AM to 12:00 PM

**Decal sales will continue when school starts August 10th thru August 24th.**

#### **Hours:**

Before school - 8:00 AM to 8:25 AM

After school - 3:30 PM to 4:00 PM

**NOTE:** Students must purchase their parking decal by August 24th in order to park in the RHS Student Lot.

Students parked in the lot without a decal will be subject to disciplinary action.
