 - a. Approve minutes

2. Treasurer's Message
 - a. Auction - Estimated net profit - \$77,410
 - b. ASE - another 12,000 beyond what anticipated
 - c. Birthday Table expenses increasing
 - d. Technology expense is over
 - e. 20,000 left in curriculum enhancement. Some will go to projectors

3. Fundraising
 - a. Auction - next year...
 - i. Chairs should have the freedom to choose date and venue
 - ii. Business sponsors

 - v. Volunteers - ask other local schools or high school students
 - vi. May have a new chair for next year

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4. Programs

- a. Grandparents breakfast - expect more than have signed up. Volunteers needed
- b. Talent show - new date and venue this year. April 9th at Roosevelt. Rehearsals may be in music room.
- c. Space night - there will be a planetarium (20 kids at a time). Female astronaut coming.
- d. Awards - re submitting the garden and submitting multicultural night and Dolphin Academy.
- e. Beautification asking to have sprinklers checked.
- f. Announcement to be made in Mabry Minute about 5 new hand sanitizer stations (in and out of main office, 2 by cafeteria and going into media center). Lunch key pads are being disinfected between classes.
- g. Hanging more posters in bathrooms about washing hands.

5. Safety
