DEADLINE

March 8, 2019 is the deadline to return completed applications.

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

1. Be a resident of Edgewater
2. Be enrolled in a public or an accredited private school within Volusia County
3. Demonstrate 20 hours of local community service
4. Submit a 500 word essay to include experience with the required community service hours, future education goals and subsequent career plans
5. Minimum GPA of 3.0
6. Financial need
7. Letters of recommendation (1 personal, 1 academic)
8. Possible interview with the Scholarship Committee
