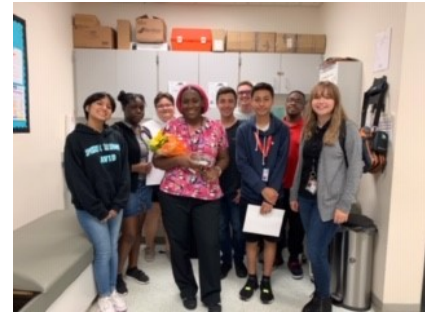


# HOSA WEEK NOVEMBER 3-8, 2019

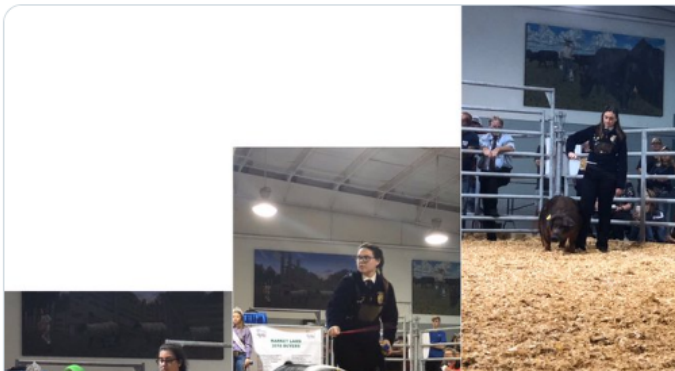
# 75th Annual Volusia County Fair & Youth Show - "Remember When"
