Knight Families,

As we reach the end of our 3rd week of eLearning, I wanted to reach out to everyone to share my thoughts on the past few weeks. First, I would like to thank everyone for reaching out to the school, continuing to offer your support and feedback as we adjust to our new normal. We have fielded calls and emails from many parents and students with helpful suggestions and resources to provide to our Knight community. Second, I would like to commend our teachers and students for your resilience and dedication to learning. As of last week, we obtained 100% attendance with students working in Edsby to obtain lessons and submit work. Admittedly, this has been a monumental task that has required near daily revision in order to appropriately meet the needs of our students.
