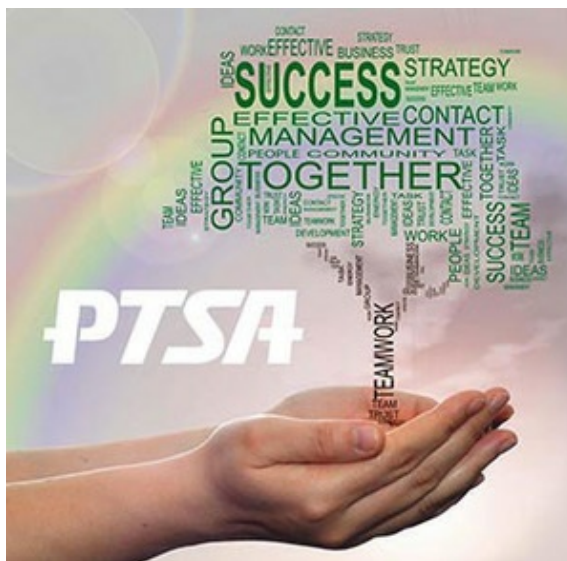

Naviance Student

Because of generous donations from our Robinson High School Foundation Partners, RHS is able to provide all of our students with

access to Naviance Student, a software platform dedicated to College & Career Readiness.

All Robinson students have an account. Seniors use this platform in the college application process to manage their applications, transcripts and letters of recommendations. Information about college representative visits and scholarships are also updated on Naviance Student. Your counselor will be dispersing and updating all important information through your account. Seniors should check often!

All students will benefit from utilizing Naviance Student beginning in 9th grade. There are tools for career exploration, college selection, and resume building. Students can enter their activities into the resume builder during each school year to make it easier when it is time to ask teachers for recommendation letters and fill out applications.

Students are able to access Naviance Student from the RHS website under Programs and Resources menu tab, then College and Career Center. The direct URL link is shown below. We recommend your student Bookmark the login page!
