ALLERGY SEASON

Each spring, summer, and fall, plants release tiny pollen grains to fertilize other plants. Most of the pollens that cause allergic reactions come from trees, weeds, and arasses

What are some Symptoms of Pollen	How Can I Reduce Allergic Reactions to
<ul><li>Allergies?</li><li>Runny nose</li><li>Sneezing</li></ul>	• Limit outdoor activities when
<ul> <li>Itchy nose, eyes, and mouth</li> </ul>	pollen count is high  • Bathe and shampoo hair daily to
<ul><li>Stuffy nose</li><li>Red or watery eyes</li></ul>	remove pollen  • Wash bedding in hot, soapy` water
<ul> <li>Swelling aroung the eyes</li> </ul>	once a week  Keep windows closed during pollen season




