## Health NEWS

### ALLERGY SEASON

Each spring, summer, and fall, plants release tiny pollen grains to fertilize other plants. Most of the pollens that cause allergic reactions come from trees, weeds, and grasses.

**What are some Symptoms of Pollen Allergies?**

- Runny nose
- Sneezing
- Itchy nose, eyes, and mouth
- Stuffy nose
- Red or watery eyes
- Swelling around the eyes

**How Can I Reduce Allergic Reactions to Pollen?**

- Limit outdoor activities when pollen count is high
- Bathe and shampoo hair daily to remove pollen
- Wash bedding in hot, soapy` water once a week
- Keep windows closed during pollen season



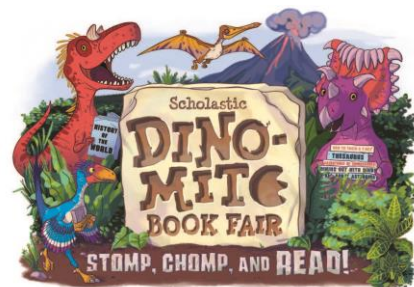
