

NOTICE OF TAX FOR SCHOOL CAPITAL OUTLAY 2016-2017

The Madison County School Board will soon consider a measure to continue to impose a 1.5 mill property tax for the capital outlay projects listed herein.

This tax is in addition to the school board's proposed tax of 5.421 mills for operating expenses and is proposed solely at the discretion of the school board.

The Capital Outlay tax will generate approximately \$1,041,461 to be used for the following projects:

CONSTRUCTION AND REMODELING

MCHS – Final year of continued renovation and remodeling project

MAINTENANCE, RENOVATION AND REPAIR

Safety Corrections

District Wide Renovations and Repairs

MOTOR VEHICLES

Purchase or Lease of 9 School Buses

New and replacement equipment, computers, enterprise resource software, and S.1011.71(2), F.S., Eligible expenditures in support of Digital CLASSROOM plans pursuant to S.1011.62(12), F.S.

Purchase of Security Equipment

Purchase of Food Service Equipment

Purchase of School Wide Equipment

Purchase of Furniture and Equipment

Purchase of School Technology (computers, tablets, software, etc.)

Payment of costs of leasing relocatable educational facilities

Leasing and/or purchasing of portable classrooms

Payment of Premiums for Property and Casualty Insurance Necessary to Insure the Educational and Ancillary Plants of the School Districts

Insurance Premiums on District Plant facilities
