



HOW TO READ YOUR
SCHEDULE

- Career Res & Dec = 6th grade Elective Wheel
 - 1st semester only
 - Students will select an elective for 2nd semester
- Crit Think = Critical Thinking = 8th grade IB Design
- Int Wlng = 6th grade World Language
 - 1st semester - Spanish, 2nd semester - French
- HRM = Homeroom (only class listed as annual)
 - Homeroom is the same as 1st period
- CAB = Computer Applied Business (7th grade IB computer course)
- Compre Grd 6/7 = 6th grade PE (year long course with A and B day)
- Compre Grd 6/7 = 7th grade PE (semester course)
 - opposite semester is CAB
- Compre Grd 7/8 = 8th grade PE (semester course)
 - opposite semester is Critical Thinking



WHEN DO I HAVE LUNCH?

- 4th period = all 6th grade students have lunch
- 5th period = all 7th grade students have lunch
- 6th period = all 8th grade students have lunch
