- * (4) Demonstrate techniques in activities, such as drawing, painting and modeling, using standard and teacher prepared instructional aids.
- (5) Develop instructional plans and organize class time to provide a balanced program of instruction, demonstration and working time.
- (6) Provide individual and small group instruction in order to adapt the curriculum to the needs of students with varying intellectual and artistic abilities, and to accommodate a variety of instructional activities.

- (25) Maintain written records of staffings, parent contacts, Individual Educational Plans, and evidence of preparation for class (lesson plans).
- (26) Assist classroom teachers, parents, and students in recognizing potential candidates for the gifted program.
