JOB DESCRIPTION

TEACHER, VOCATIONAL: INDUSTRY ED./CARPENTRY

QUALIFICATIONS:

(1) A minimum of six years full-time or the equivalent of part-time occupational experience in cabinet work, carpentry, or building construction occupations.

If a person is a building contractor, the district can use the percentage of time worked as a carpenter or supervising carpenters. Two (2) years of carpentry may be combined with four (4) years of experience in cabinetmaking.

OR

(2) Bachelor's Degree in Construction and three years of full-time or the equivalent of part-time occupational experience in carpentry occupations.

(3) Preference for OSHA certification and NCCER certification.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

Knowledge of the construction industry and specifically carpentry. Knowledge of project based learning and the ability to integrate soft-skill instruction into competency-based content activities. Knowledge of education and ability to work with students. Knowledge of education or the willingness to learn the best instructional practices to engage students in learning the carpentry content and skills. Ability to plan and implement activities for maximum effectiveness. Ability to effectively assess levels of student achievement, analyze test results, and prescribe action for improvement. Ability to maintain appropriate student supervision so that students have a safe and orderly environment in which to learn and work. Knowledge of basic shop safety and OSHA standards. Good oral and written communication with students, parents, and co-workers. Basic computer skills.

- * (9) Assist in enforcement of school rules, administrative regulations, and Board policy.
- *(10) Implement a variety of instructional techniques to meet varying learning styles of students.
- *(11) Assist students in learning to accept responsibility, demonstrate respect for people and property, and demonstrate self-discipline.
- *(12) Promote and assist in student participation in official student organizations that are recognized as a vital part of the vocational program.
- *(13) Provide students with the latest research on careers in the vocational area being taught.
- *(14) Identify business partners and coordinate activities with business partners designed to meet curricular objectives.
- *(15) Travel as needed to meet curricular objectives.
- (16) Perform other incidental tasks consistent with the goals and objectives of this position.
- *(17) Ability to work in a constant state of alertness and safe manner.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

Heavy Work: Exerting up to 100 pounds of force occasionally, and up to 50 pounds of force frequently and/or up to 20 pounds of force as needed to move objects.
