ORGANIZATION DESCRIPTION:

2. Advisor will encourage membership, ensure that the Chapter is involved in community events, prepare students for district contest by organizing and supervising after school practice, chaperone HOSA leadership conferences and competitions, help district winners to prepare for the state contest, host district meetings on a rotational basis, oversee the fundraising events for the HOSA chapter and any other duties assigned by the school principal related to the HOSA chapter.
