### WANTED! STUDENT GOVERNMENT FRESHMEN CLASS OFFICERS

Table 2: SCHOOL STUDENT ID – First Issue FREE

Students are required to carry their I.D. on their person at all times on campus. First school ID each year is provided free of charge. This card identifies you as a Seabreeze student. A current 2017-18 school ID is required for checking out media books & textbooks, lunch in the café, on or off campus extracurricular events, and purchasing a parking decal. Replacement ID cards are \$5.

Off Campus Lunch ID \$10 per Semester (Seniors, Juniors & Sophomores only)) Students must have no outstanding obligations to purchase an "off campus lunch ID" for the first semester. To purchase an "off campus lunch ID" for the second semester students must have no outstanding obligations and meet the following attendance requirement: CANNOT EXCEED 9 TARDIES AND/OR ABSENCES FOR 5TH PERIOD ONLY FOR THE FIRST SEMESTER. Note: Freshmen do not have off campus lunch privileges. Attention Parent/Guardian! If you do not wish for your son/daughter to leave campus during lunch, contact Student Resources at 258-4674 ext. 54628.

Table 3: PARKING \$42.00

Senior & Juniors Only

Students must have NO FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS to apply to park on campus. The following items are necessary to register for a parking decal: Parking Registration form signed by your parent; 2017-18 Student ID; Driver's License; and Proof of Insurance on the vehicle you will be driving to school. Parking for seniors and juniors will be in the North and South lots. Note: Sophomore parking may become available at a later date.

## TEXTBOOKS

Textbooks will be issued during the 1st week of school. You must have a current Student ID & preliminary schedule to check out textbooks.

Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subsection (3) of section 1006.28, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 1006.28 Duties of district school board, district school superintendent; and school principal regarding K-12 instructional materials.—

(3) SCHOOL PRINCIPAL.—The school principal has the following duties for the management and care of instructional materials at the school:

(b) Money collected for lost or damaged books; enforcement.—The school principal shall collect from each student or the student's parent the purchase price of any instructional material the student has lost, destroyed, or unnecessarily damaged and to report and transmit the money collected to the district school superintendent. The failure to collect such sum upon reasonable effort by the school principal may result in the suspension of the student from participation in extracurricular activities or satisfaction of the debt by the student through community service activities at the school site as determined by the school.

## VISITOR POLICY

## PARENT PICK-UP AND DROP OFF

In an effort to make the campus a safer more secure place for all, access to the North student parking lot will be limited to students with current parking permits and will not be utilized for dropping off/picking up students. Parents are to utilize the loop in front of the school to drop off and pick up students. For safety and to minimize usage parents are encouraged to pull as far forward into the loop as possible.

## WANT TO DRIVE???

The Florida Legislature has enacted requirements that schools report to the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles (DHSMV) the names of those students who fail to satisfy the attendance requirements. Specifically, this refers to those students who accumulate 15 unexcused absences (excluding out-of-school suspension) within 90 calendar days or who have withdrawn from school under one of the state designated dropout codes.

The legislation further provides that those students who FAIL to satisfy attendance requirements will be INELIGIBLE for driving privileges.

## PAY OBLIGATIONS

Students with obligations will not be allowed to purchase a parking decal (seniors/juniors only) or have the privilege of leaving campus for lunch (seniors/juniors/sophomores – freshmen are not permitted off campus for lunch). In addition, you must meet other criteria as stated in the Orientation Newsletter. ## ATTENDANCE

Regular school attendance is critical to a child's success in school. We know that parents share our dream of helping children to be the best that they can be. If we work together, this dream can and will become a reality. The Florida Legislature find that "poor academic performance is associated with nonattendance and that schools must take an active role in enforcing attendance as a means of improving the performance of many students." (F.S. 103.26)

Florida State Law says that:

- All children between the ages of 6 & 18 must attend school regularly. Students may withdraw at age 16 with parents permission.
- Parents are legally responsible for their children's attendance.
- If a child accumulates a minimum of 15 unexcused absences within 90 days, it is a violation of the Compulsory School Attendance Law (please note that law also requires a doctor's note is required after 15 absences.)
- After 5 unexcused absences within a calendar month or 10 unexcused absences within 90 days, the school's Student Success Team may review the attendance to determine if early patterns of truancy are developing.
- If the Student Success Team determines that a pattern of truancy is developing, a meeting with the parents must be scheduled to identify potential remedies.
- If parents refuse to participate in the strategies recommended by the Student Success Team, because they believe the strategies are unnecessary or inappropriate, they may appeal to the District School Board. If the District School Board's final determination is that the strategies of the Student Success Team are appropriate, the parents are expected to cooperate.
- In the event of the truancy continues and the parents remain uncooperative, the District School Superintendent may seek legal action against the parents.

Please call by noon on the day of the student's all day absence and as early in the day as possible if the student needs to checkout early.

## **PARENTS NOTE: NO OUTPASSES WILL BE GIVEN FOR OFF-CAMPUS LUNCH. NO EXCEPTIONS.**

When calling please have:

- Child's name
- Alpha Code
- Reason for the absence
- Name of person calling

This will ensure accurate attendance reporting and alleviate problems with make-up work.

## WRITING CHECKS TO SCHOOLS

Although the district is asking that our payments move toward 100% online, your check is welcome at Seabreeze High School at this time. The District recognizes that occasionally a parent may inadvertently overdraw a checking account and a check may be returned by the bank. In order to recover these funds in a private and professional manner, Volusia County Schools has contracted with CHECKredi, a company specializing in the collection of returned checks.

**Each check written to the school must be made out to Seabreeze High School with the maker's name pre-printed on the check (no starter checks) and must include the maker's physical address and phone number (including area code). Please use blue or black ink.**

When a person writes a check to a school or the District, the person writing the check agrees that, if the check is returned, it may be re-presented electronically on the same account for the full face amount and a fee established by Florida law.

CHECKredi will contact you by mail and by telephone in order to make arrangements to pay before attempting to re-present the check electronically. Payments of the check and fee may also be made online at [www.checkredi.com](http://www.checkredi.com) using a credit card, debit card or electronic check without any additional fees. For a convenience fee, payments may be made over the telephone at (877) 524-7334 by credit card, debit card, or electronic check. Payments cannot be made at the school or the District.



## Give Back Program
